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Webinar on National Education Policy-2020 Date: 19th Oct-2020

Jointly organized by SJMVS Arts and Commerce College for Women, IQAC, 5 kar BN NCC Dharwad, Karnataka State Akkamahadevi Women's University and Teacher's Association Vijayapura.

A special talk on National Education Policy was organized by the IQAC Shree Jagadguru Moorusaviramath Vidyavardhak Sanghas Arts and Commerce College for Women, Hubballi, in association with the Karnataka State Akkamahadevi Women's University, Teachers Association and 5 Karnataka Girls BN NCC Dharwad.

The speaker Dr. A. M. Narahari, former Registrar of St. Aloysius College, Mangalore stated that the NEP-2020 is a learner centered policy and it provides more opportunities to the students. The policy is going to bring about a paradigm shift in the field of education and addresses the prominent issues of higher education. Dr. Narahari felt that the NEP focuses on the up-liftment of the rural/backward areas and which will enable the rural students to access education through credit choice based system. He opined that the most of the regulations stated in the policy for primary and secondary education are already implemented but for higher education it should be implemented systematically. The UGC and State governments have to coordinate properly in implementation of NEP. Teachers get ample of opportunities to evaluate teaching learning evaluation process scientifically through credit based system under NEP.

NEP is the concept of multi disciplinary approach but, implementation of such system in India will be challenging.

At the institutional level it will have to undergo a big change with no affiliation system & no unitary universities. We have to get back to the generalized universities



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and at the same time the existing 940 universities will be reduced to 1/3rd of the total universities. At the college level two types of systems will be allowed whether as a Autonomous or a Constituent college of university.

He spoke about the four parallel autonomous regulatory bodies mentioned in the NEP which will be monitored by the Higher Education Commission.

He said that no formal training qualification framework, suggested in the NEP. However the policy will be fully implemented by 2040.

Dr. A. M. Narhari expressed that too much of a time gap for implementation of NEP may not make it very effective by then the policy may be infectious.

This Virtual session was attended by 84 participants, comprising faculties, students, all the office bearers of Karnataka State Akkamahadevi Women's University, KSAWU Teacher's Association, Vijayapura, Dr. Indira shetkar, Hon'bl President, Dr. Lingaraj Angadi, President, Dr. Mallikarjun Metri, Secertary, Dr. Rajeshwari Shettar, Treasurer, Col. T.J.S. Thind, Commanding Officer, 5 KAR BN NCC, Dharwad have been participated.


Department of Commerce Organized Online special talk on Career Planning

Language should be spoken with childlike simplicity

A Special Talk on "Phonetics and Intonation" was organised on 10th Feb 2021. Dr. Gurunath Badiger, Associate Professor of English, Govt. First Grade College & PG Centre Dharwad was the Resource Person .He began his talk by rendering his beneficial tips to students on how they can know the sounds which are produced. He said language is that which is spoken through a speaker's tongue. Today the world has variety of English, that is why it is necessary to develop a standard pronunciation. Phonetics is a clear understanding of words and acquiring standard accent. Phonetics includes, Speech Mechanism, Articulatory System, Articulation of vowels and consonants. The speech organs, the tongue and the lips are used in various positions to produce speech. The average rapidity of vocal chords is 150-300cps in women and 120 to 150cps in men. He also dealt with description and classification of Sounds produced with or without any obstruction in the oral cavity in its voiced and voiceless sounds. IPA- International Phonetic Association sets the standard pronunciation. He advised the students to learn words, their meanings, spellings and pronunciation from text and context. Illustrating the announcements in railway stations, mobile intimations and reciting the poem 'Daffodils', he demonstrated the importance of pronunciation and intonation. He elaborated on word stress and sentence stress and the significance of intonation in communication. 56 students of B.AI, II, III benefited from the special talk. The staff of the department were present. The lecture began with an Invocation song by students of BAII. Netravati Hiremath of BAIII welcomed the gathering.
